

Auxilium

The Auxilium system is a secure database that Ambulance trusts can access when called to attend a patient. The database contains information on individuals, with the information available uploaded and determined solely by that individual.

No information is extracted and uploaded directly from GP or hospital records, so Auxilium is completely unrelated to The Summary Care Record, EMIS Web data streaming (such as The Oxfordshire Care Summary), or any of the massive clinical data repositories such as The Hampshire Health Record or The Berkshire Health Record (Connected Care).

The AUXILIUM system is available free of charge to all Ambulance trusts all over the UK.

The databases is available to all citizens who live in the catchment area covered by South Central Ambulance Service (Berkshire, Buckinghamshire, Hampshire and Oxfordshire), and all residents who live on the Isle of Wight.

Auxilium are also offering all schools in the UK free database records for their pupils.

The process of getting information is straightforward: you contact Auxilium requesting a number and they send you an email back with your unique number and a link to the database website .

You then enters your unique number and password and upload any information you wish, such as DOB , NHS number , next of kin, allergies , medical information , instructions , directions to your house etc.

Your can then display the logo and AUXILIUM number where you wish, or as a key ring fob, bracelet , ID card etc .

Only the AUXILIUM number is displayed.

The cost of an AUXILIUM number is £1 per year per person .

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The Auxilium System

Is a unique online identification database that can be used in Emergency situations to quickly and accurately identify patients at the site of an accident or in circumstances when the patient is unable to convey information for themselves.

Information on the Auxilium Database is provided voluntarily by the user/patient when they sign up and can be continuously updated by them at anytime with further information.

The Auxilium System speeds up access to NHS patient records. Information entered onto the online web form including NHS number and name, to voluntary information including next of Kin, medication, allergies, past problems or illnesses etc. This data can be relayed direct to the location of the accident speeding up decision making.

Life saving information available 24/7 for just £1 per year

£1 per year per person is all it costs to sign up and **FREE** to all Emergency services to use as well as **FREE** to schools signing up in the first year. Organisations will benefit by signing up members en masse, e.g. a school signing up all of its pupils, or a Construction company signing up all of its workers.

Users are provided with a unique identification number and high visibility Auxilium logo which can be downloaded and used to display via labels for clothing, work wear, keyrings, phone covers, or medical bracelets, identification cards etc.

Emergency Services are trained to look for the Auxilium logo and will be able to obtain information from their control centre.

The System is SSL certified and HTTPS enabled and records the dates that files are accessed via Emergency Services
