In response to your request:

Data sharing carried out within the Sussex ICS as part of our Sussex Integrated Dataset is managed in accordance with all the appropriate legislation and policies.

As detailed within the DPIA and as you note in your request email, the Sussex Integrated Dataset (SID) receives data extracts directly from providers and does not use data from the Sussex Shared Care Record. All data flowed to the SID is de-identified and encrypted at source by the providers in line with the Information Commissioner's Office Anonymisation Code of Practice.
